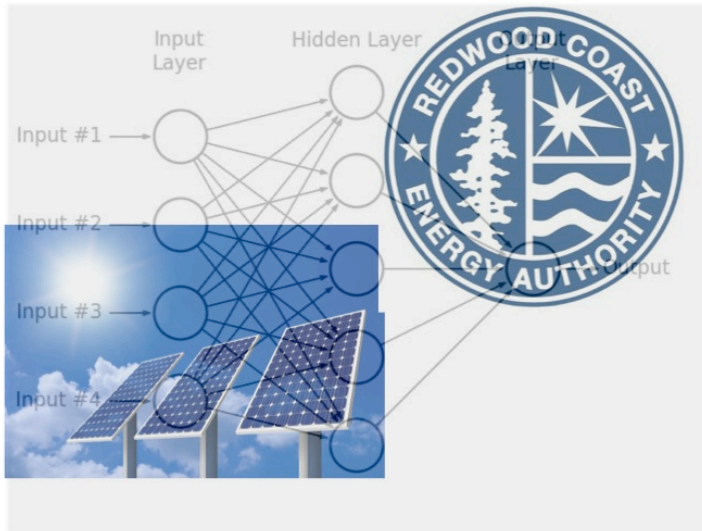

PIC Math course: Preparing Students to Enter Non-teaching Careers

The "Preparation for Industrial Careers in Math" (PIC Math) course was first offered in Spring 2017 to upper division Math majors. The goal of the course is to prepare Math majors to enter non-teaching careers upon graduation and to give them practice with complex real-world problems. To achieve this, (1) students work on projects provided by industry (or business) partners; (2) the course provides career-education to Math students. The talk will describe the course structure, the projects and industry partners proposed for the course in Spring 2018, some lessons from last year, and the career education component of the class.

Professor Bori Mazzag is Chair of the Mathematics Department at Humboldt State University, where she teaches and conducts research in mathematical modeling.
