From 2012 to 2016, he was the computer science curriculum developer and lead instructor for Level Playing Field Institute's Summer Math and Science Honors (SMASH) Academy. He has given keynotes at the 2018 Joint Special Populations Annual CTE Conference and the 2019 UCLA exploreTech. LA Conference. He received the Computer Science Teacher of the Year Award from the El Camino ACM Chapter in 2017.
